

WEEKLY ONLINE TRAINING AVAILABLE with WENDY UTTLEY



On Wednesday 17th September we made a great start to our new weekly online training course with a range of schools and parents joining the session. Sessions are followed up with additional handouts, the Powerpoint and the video recording.

- ◆ The weekly online training offers our full range of training covering Introduction to Down syndrome, signing, teaching number skills, time and money, using visuals to teach communication skills and reading language intervention. Each topic is covered over several weeks.
- ♦ At the end of each topic there is a one hour online group consultation session.
- ♦ There are 22 sessions in total and these can be booked individually at £5 per session, or as a bundle for £80.
- ♦ The sessions run EVERY WEDNESDAY, 10am to 11am during term time.
- ♦ Sessions are recorded so that you don't need to miss any.





All course are divided into several one hour online sessions. Topics covers are:

- Introduction to Down syndrome
- Signing and Down syndrome
- Teaching basic number skills to children with Down syndrome and other learning difficulties using the Numicon approx
- Teaching number skills beyond 10, time & money
- Let's make it visual using visual resources to support speech, language, communication and literacy skills
- Reading, Language Intervention for children with Down syndrome

Each topic will be followed with an online consultation for participants. In total 22 sessions spread over the first 2 terms. Sessions will run EVERY WEDNESDAY MORNING 10am to 11am.

If you are interested there's still chance to join the weekly training as a full course, or a one off session.

In October the 'Signing and Down Syndrome' course will be delivered, followed in November by 'Let's Make it Visual - using visual resources to teach speech, language, communication and literacy skills and, in December, 'Teaching Basic Number Skills'

In addition we will continue to deliver our workshops on behaviour, toileting and sexuality relationships education—these will be online and run for 2 hours per week over several weeks. Places will be limited.

AIMING TO BETTER MEET SCHOOL STAFF AVAILABILITY

We hope that offering our training via online weekly sessions will enable more schools to access the training needed to fully educate and include a child with Down syndrome. Acting on feedback it will remove the time for travel and enable schools to better plan cover.

EARLY DEVELOPMENT GROUPS

All groups are back in full swing. Wendy and Laura are currently delivering six groups and five one to one sessions for children with more complex needs.

FEEDBACK REPORT—our feedback report is excellent and can be downloaded <u>here</u>.

A few comments are included here:

Able to sit in group times longer, able to wait longer in taking turns. Better number recognition, better sound knowledge, speech improvements and improvement in listening skills.

My child's has shown great progress with his speech. Vocally his sounds are more distinctive. I have also seen progress in his reading, counting and memory skills.

The sessions are really helpful. My son enjoys them and it is a good opportunity to interact with his peers. It is really helpful seeing tasks demonstrated by Laura in the session and then being able to practice this ourselves in the group and again once at home. The resources given out in the groups are fantastic. Laura is very approachable and easy to talk to about any concerns regarding development.

FUNDING

We have recently been awarded some funding towards these sessions from the Freemasons and are also through to stage 2 application to the National Lottery. Early Development Groups cost the charity about £1000 each month. They are currently being part funded from our reserves.



SAM RECEIVES KEIGHLEY COMMUNITY AWARD

On Friday 19th September Sam was invited to attend a celebration at Keighley Civic Hall. The room was packed with locally important people, including the Lord Mayor of Keighley Cllr Chris Herd, Robbie Moore MP, the Principal of Keighley College and the Chief of Police. Following a three course meal and entertainment, the winners of the 2025 Keighley Community Awards were announced in turn. Sam won the

Gary Pedley's Community Award for his work helping to set up and run the charity shop in December 2024 when his mum, Wendy, was out of action following her accident. In addition to having to care for his mum and staff the shop he continued to work at his part time job.
