

It is vitally important that all adults working with a child with Down syndrome understands their learning needs and how to meet these needs. All teaching staff are welcome to join our Introduction to Down syndrome course for FREE. It will run at the beginning of each term. To enhance your practice further we suggest staff working closely with the child are also trained in signing, using visuals to support language development and teaching basic number skills. Each term these additional three courses will follow on from the Introduction to Down syndrome

course over several weeks.

The cost of these additional courses is usually £200. If you book all three together the cost is reduced to £150, plus you can have a further 50% off one other course of your choice from:

Introduction to Down syndrome FREE

Wednesday 20th Sept '23. Repeated 17th Jan '24 and 17th Apr '24, 9.30am to 12.30pm

This session will introduce Down syndrome to people who have little experience of working with children and young people who have Down syndrome. It will cover society's view of Down syndrome, health implications, inclusion, the specific learning profile of people with Down syndrome and strengths and weaknesses in the classroom; outlining ways to ensure your teaching meets their learning needs. Promoting positive behaviour and managing behaviours will also be discussed. Vital training for all involved in the education, inclusion and development of a person with Down syndrome.



Signing and children with Down syndrome

This course is over 2 weeks. 27th Sept'23 & 4th Oct'23, 9.30 to 11.30am REPEATED: 24th Jan'24 & 31st Jan'24, 9.30 to 11.30am 24th Apr'24 & 1st May'24, 9.30 to 11.30am

<u>Session 1</u> will cover why we use signing with children with Down syndrome and the signs for manners, animals, food, family and other people, and the alphabet.



Followed by a discussion on how behaviour can be addressed through introducing signing.

Both sessions will include practice of useful phrases and familiar children's songs. A book "Signing and Down syndrome", covering the signs in this course is available for $\pounds 7$.

It will also detail See & Learn (DSEI), visual timetables, conversation diaries and ideas to develop reading, writing and spelling skills.

COST: £60 per professional (£15 for second person from same school)/£15 per family member.



<u>Teaching basic number skills to children with Down syndrome</u> and other learning difficulties using the Numicon approach

Wednesday 18th Oct '23. Repeated 21st Feb '24 and 15th May '24, 9.30 to 12.30pm

Basic number skills are vital to enable everyday social inclusion and independence. The training will commence with an overview of the learning profile of a child with Down syndrome; exploring working memory and how this impacts on learning numbers. It will detail how children learn basic number skills - recognising numbers, saying number names, counting to find 'how many?' and early hands on addition. It will explore the challenges faced by children who have Down syndrome and other learning disabilities and demonstrate how the use of Numicon as a visual representation of number can help to overcome these difficulties and lead to increased understanding and confidence.

COST: £60 per professional (£15 for second person from same school)/£15 per family member.



Down syndrome

Wednesdays 8th & 15th Nov '23.

This training course is over 2 half days, 9.30am to 12.30pm.

The RLI programme detailed in a teacher's handbook and DVD (now a digital download) developed and produced by Down Syndrome Education International, provides a systematic structured approach via daily activities that can be finely adapted to each child. The training days will cover the theory behind the programme, how to assess a child to find a starting point, how to monitor and record progress and how to deliver the daily intervention with examples from, and reference to, the teacher's handbook and DVD.

The RLI programme comprises of two strands of intervention; a reading strand and a language strand. The aim of the RLI programme is to:

- Improve spoken language and literacy skills of children with Down syndrome.
- Improve teaching practice and support educators.

We have for a long time known reading is a strength for children with Down syndrome but not all educators are aware of this or how to ensure the children reach their full reading potential.

Transition Evening for parents and carers of children with Down syndrome

Monday 20th Nov'23, 7pm to 9pm

This workshop will be aimed at parents of young people with Down syndrome due to transition from primary to secondary school or secondary school onto adulthood.

It will discuss the different options available for secondary provision and beyond, the pros and cons of each setting, planning the transition and detail the types of courses available for your child/young person.

Discussions on transport, direct payments, personal budgets and supported employment will be included.

COST: Free to family members, otherwise £20.

Teaching number skills beyond 10, time & money

Wednesday 22nd Nov 2023, 9.30 to 3.00pm

- In the morning we will look in detail at tackling number skills beyond 10:
- ♦Rote counting in 10s, 5s, 2s, teens and counting through decades up to 100
- Recognising 2 and 3 digit numbers, place value and order
- \bullet Counting to find how many beyond 10
- \blacklozenge Adding up and taking away methods to succeed
- \blacklozenge Fractions, multiplication, division and using calculators

After lunch we will tackle time and money

Time: This workshop will equip participants with a structured programme of activities and resources, developed and written by Wendy Uttley, to help them teach the passage of time and then how, step by step, to teach a child how to tell the time.

Money: We will detail a programme written by Wendy Uttley which consists of 120 finely graded activities to help teach a person with Down syndrome or other learning disability to understand and use money. From the early stages of learning the names for the coins to working with pounds and pence this programme is suitable to use with a child from approximately 5 years of age.

Three week 'toilet training for all ages' Workshop (online)

Friday 1st, 8th & 15th December 2023, 10am to 12pm REPEATED

Friday 21st & 28th June, 5th July 2024, 10am to 12pm

Do you need help toilet training your child?

Whether it be a young child just starting or an older child who still needs to develop skills towards independent toileting you are welcome to join us. Sessions will run over three weeks and cover how the bladder develops, skills needed to use the toilet, tips on toilet training, constipation, day and night time wetting and set targets for each child. There will also be opportunities to support each other, share ideas and resources and monitor progress. The course is 2 hours a week for 3 weeks and limited to 7 families.

<u>Expectations of behaviour - understanding and modifying</u> <u>behaviours of children with Down syndrome</u>

Wednesday 13th March 2024, 9.30 to 2.30pm

By considering the learning profile of a child with Down syndrome and looking at areas of need this course will aim to address areas where difficult behaviours may develop. It will look at expectations, appropriate behaviour, including self help skills and go on to outline positive strategies using the ABC model of behaviour to focus on wanted behaviour.

COST: £80 per professional (£20 for a second person from the same school)/£20 per family member.
